## Introducing Event Chaplaincy at YMCA175

---

YMCA175 Event Chaplains will be a visual presence of the spiritual heritage of YMCA. We aim to provide a warm welcome to delegates, alongside an opportunity to receive pastoral care, chat, be listened to and pray.

## What are we looking for in an Event Chaplain?

---

An Event Chaplain should be confident in speaking to others, able to provide a listening ear and capable of offering prayer and spiritual support to delegates. They should profess an active Christian faith and be recognised by their local association as someone capable of providing pastoral care.

## What will be required of an Event Chaplain?

---

Event Chaplains will work in teams of 4 or 5 and will be present around activities that emphasise the Christian heritage of YMCA. They will be required to be available for the duration of the event, but will only work in 4 to 5 hour rotations.

## How can I become part of the team?

---

You will need to apply to be a YMCA175 event volunteer through the [event website](#). In your application you should indicate that you would like to be part of the Event Chaplaincy team.

After your application is submitted you will be contacted by one of the Event Chaplaincy team to go through your application and check your suitability.
